Evangelization with young people aged 16+ *Challenge, Opportunity, Proposal*

On Saturday 24th January 2009, the Diocesan Youth Commission (KDŽ) will be organizing the third general assembly with a focus on young people with the following theme: Evangelization with young people aged 16+: Challenge, opportunity, proposal. The aim of this assembly is to bring together pastoral workers with young people to discuss together how we can have more effective evangelization with 16+ youth.

Preliminary work in view of this assembly was done by a working group made up of the Diocesan Youth Commission of Malta, the Diocesan Youth Commission of Gozo and the Catechetical Commission. This working group has issued a draft document which shall be discussed during the Assembly and also during several focus groups which shall take place in the following weeks.

The main speakers are going to be Rev. Dr. Rene' Camilleri, the Archbishop's Delegate for Catechesis; Rev. Dr. Carl-Mario Sultana and Rev. Dr. Emanuel Magro, both lecturers in the Department of Pastoral Theology, Liturgy and Canon Law at the Faculty of Theology in the University of Malta. They will help those present to understand better the main points and challenges that emerge from this proposal.
